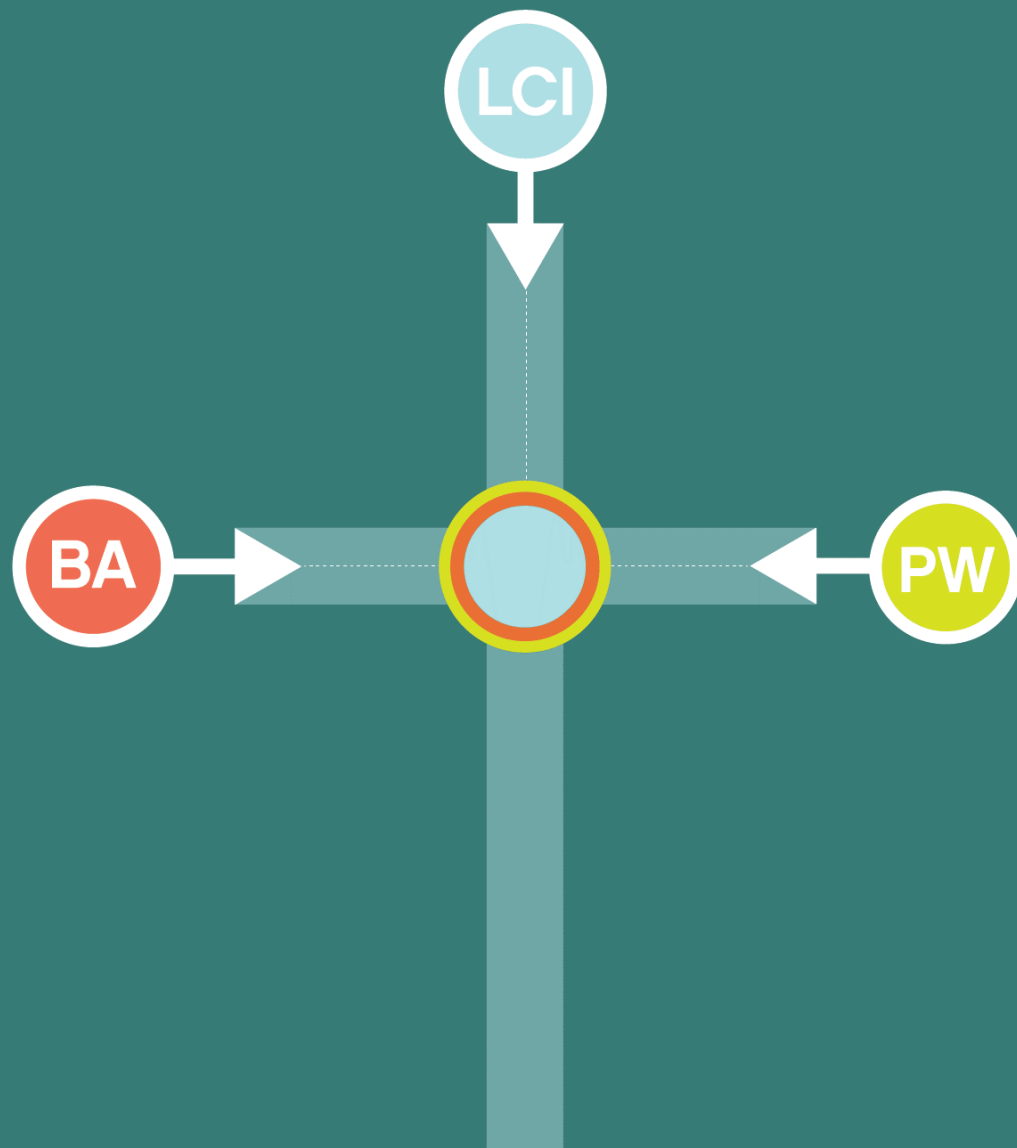

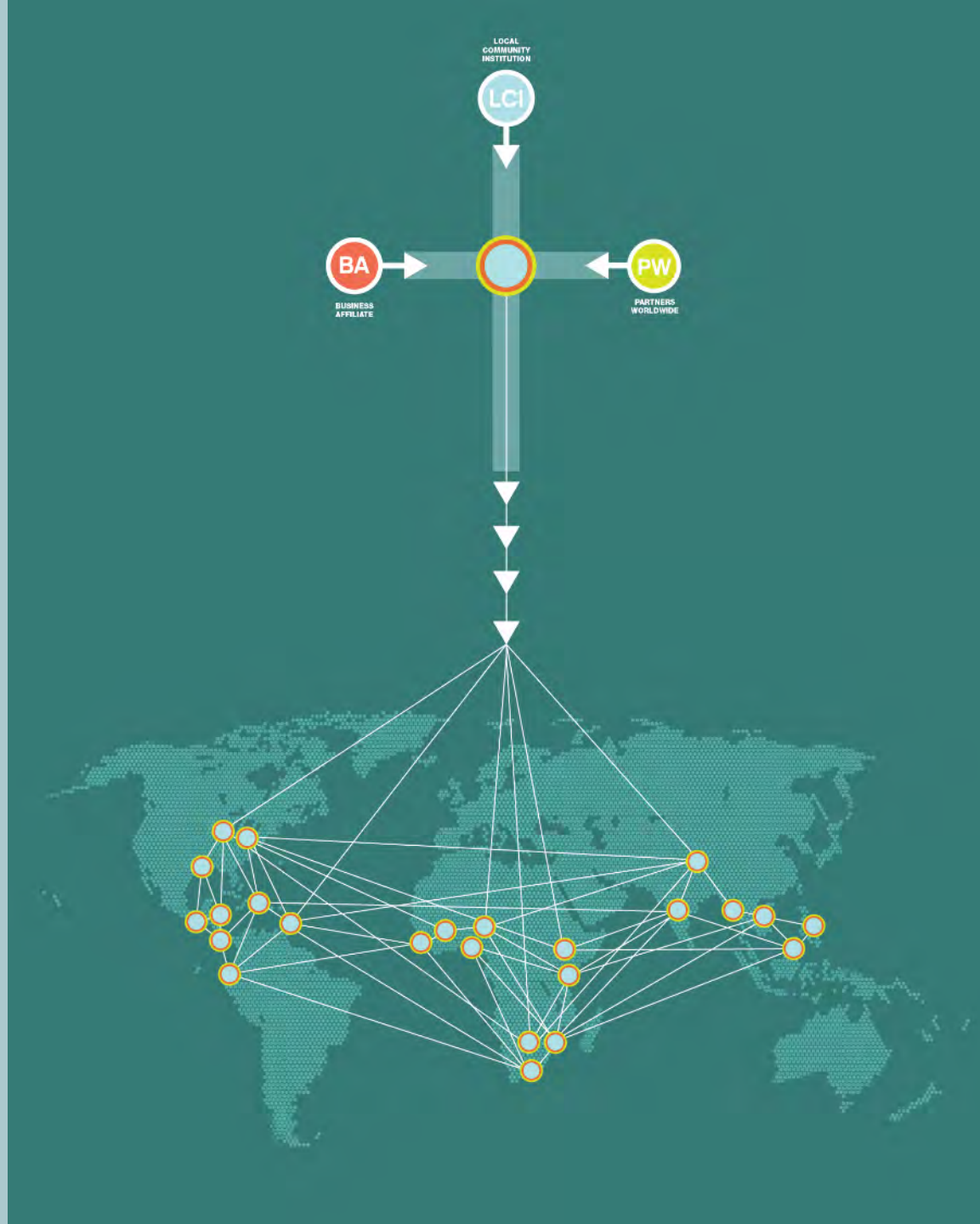

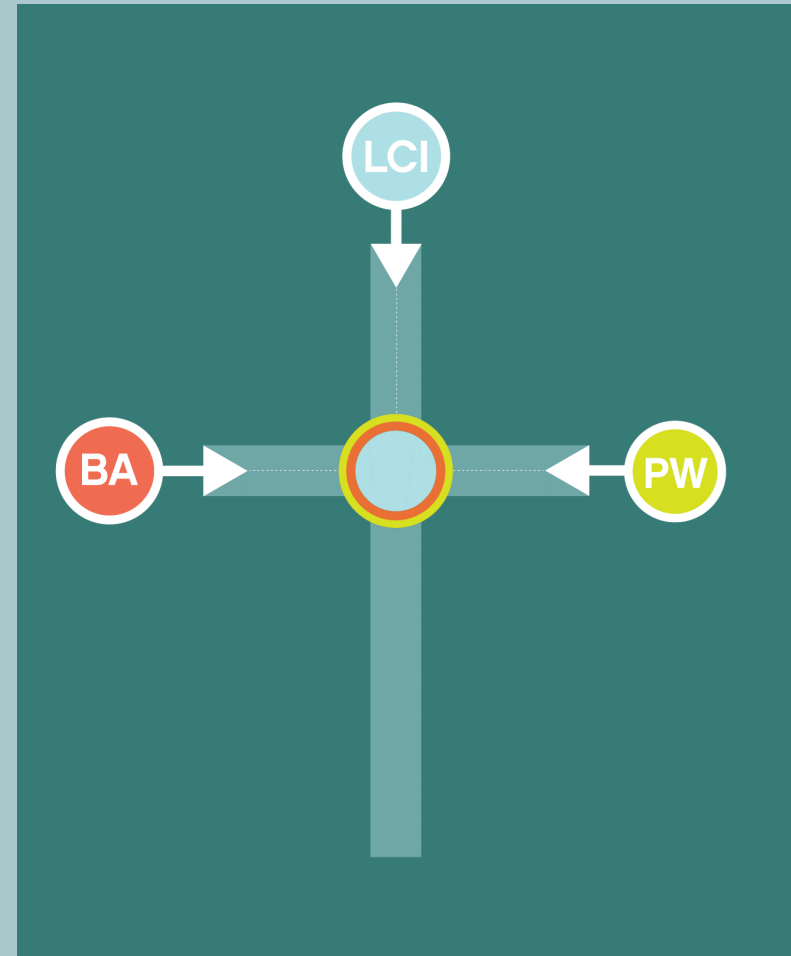

Global Indicators & Annual Impacts 2014-15

The global network of Partners Worldwide completed the 2014-15 fiscal year with 82 Local Community Institutions in over 25 countries who worked together to impact their communities with a shared vision to end poverty so that all may have life and have it abundantly.
